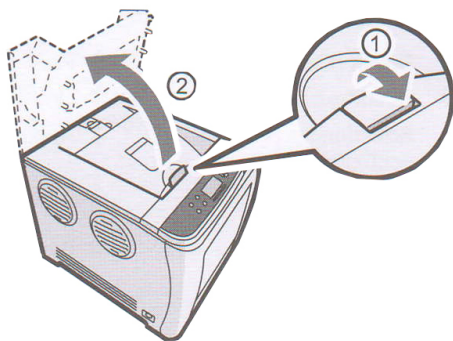
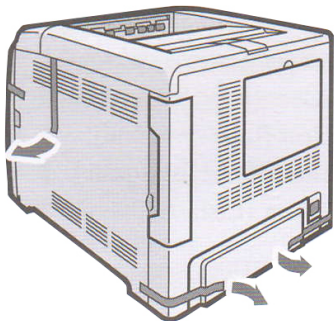
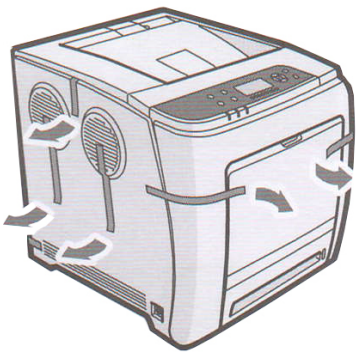
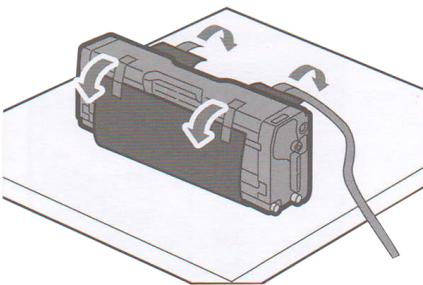
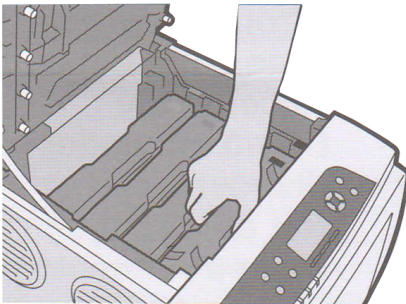
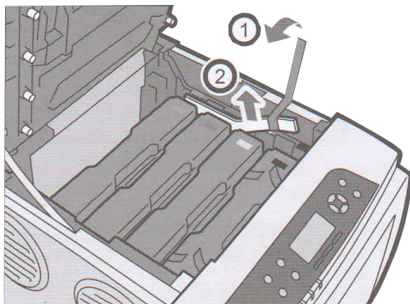
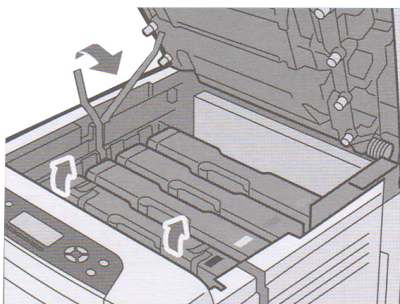


1. Unpack the machine, check all components and remove the orange tape from all sides. Then open the top lid.



2. Remove the white toner cartridge. Remove protective foam from inside the machine and protective film from the white cartridge and reinstall.



3. Using the provided USB drive, install the driver.

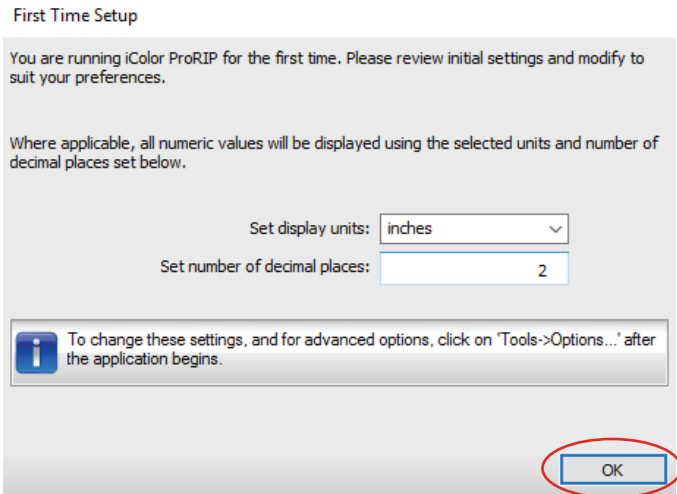


5. Install the iColor ProRIP (stored on the provided drive)

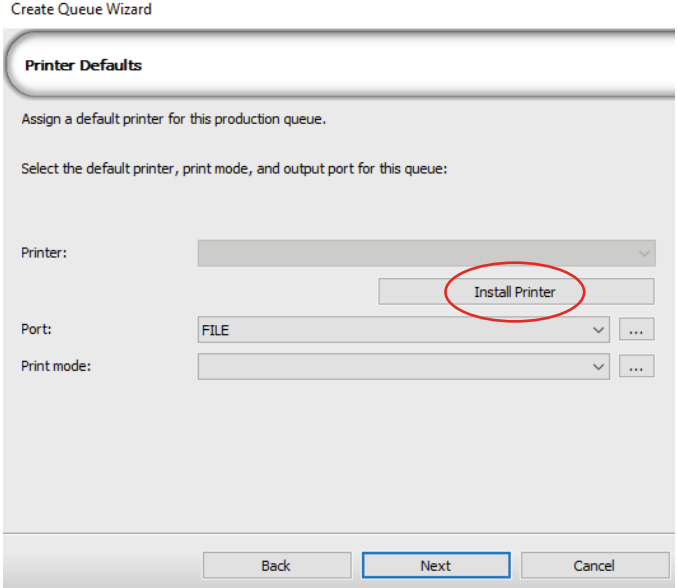


After the iColor ProRIP installation is complete, the setup will begin. Internet connection is required.

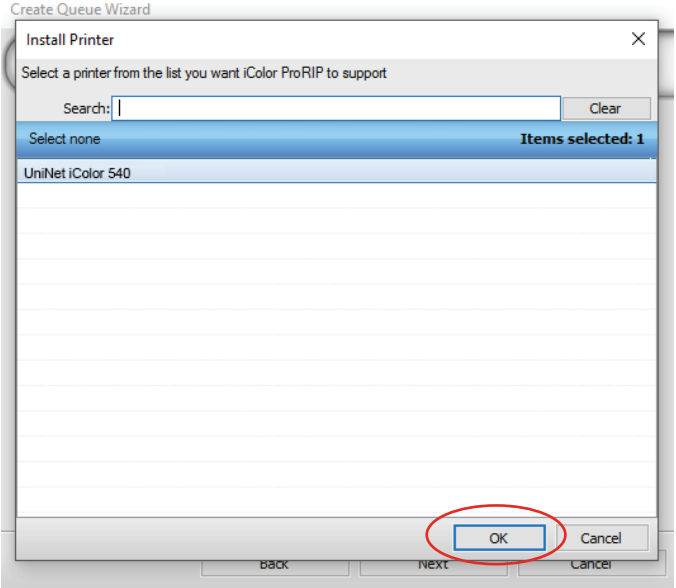
6. Confirm first time setup. And click 'OK'.



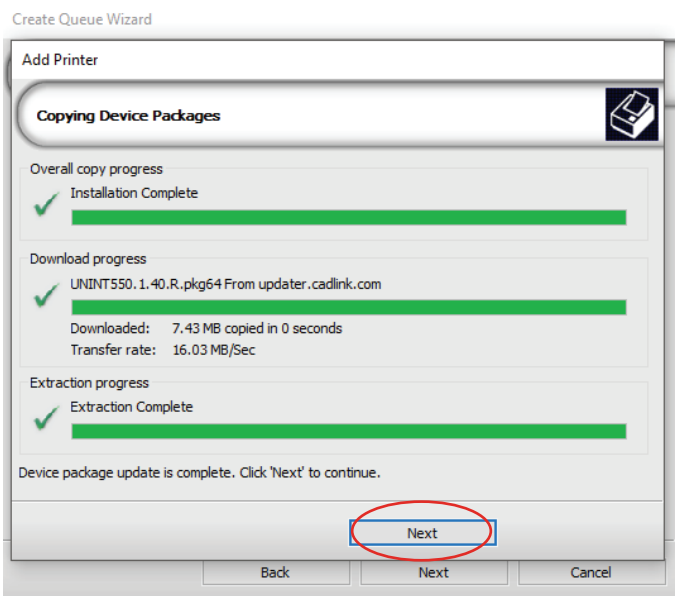
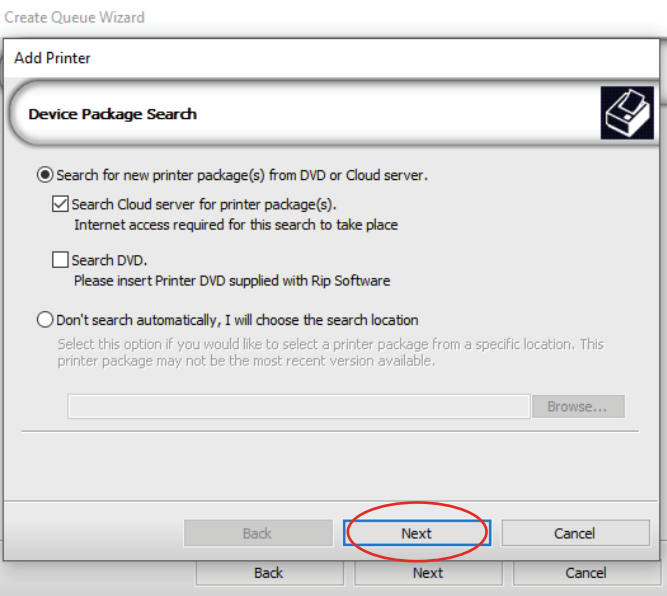
7. Click "Install Printer".



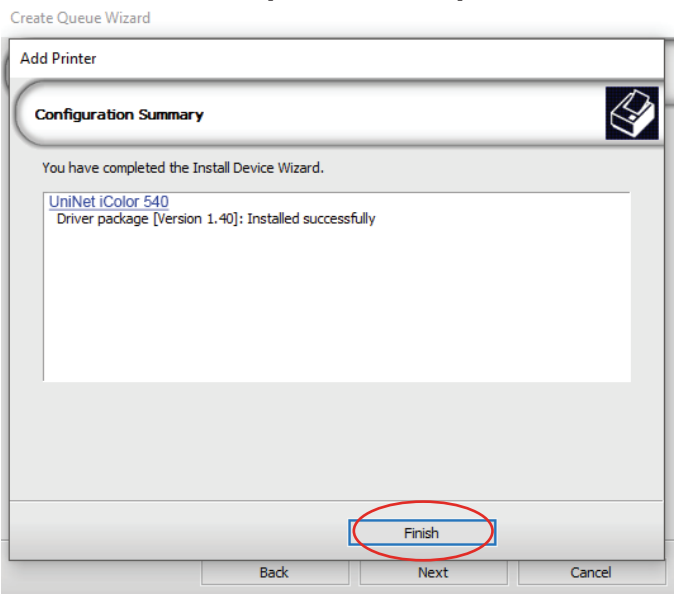
8. Choose the iColor 540 and click 'OK'.



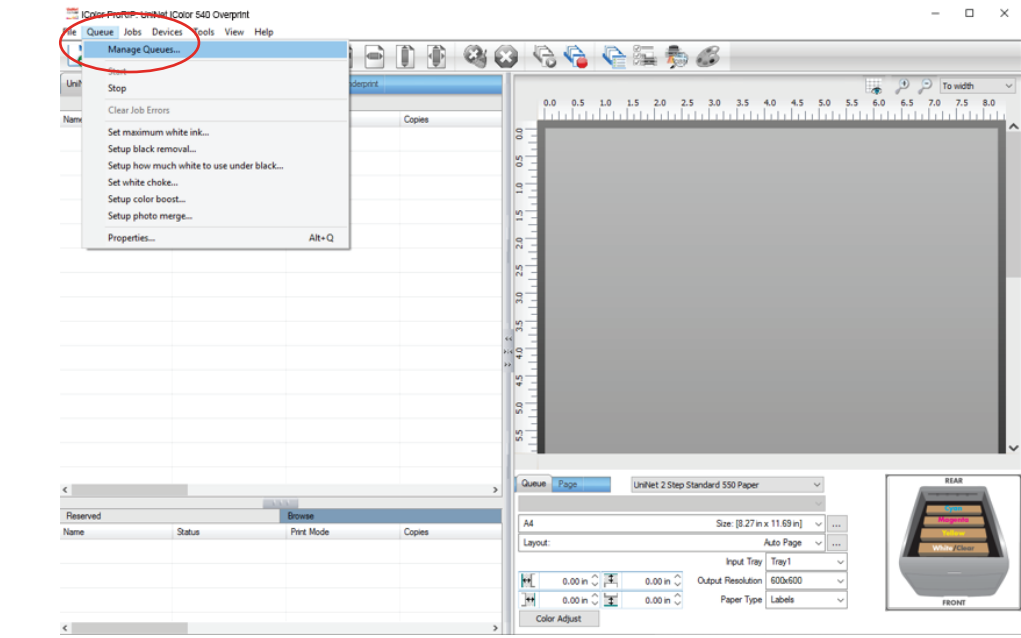
9. To install the Print Queues click 'Next'.



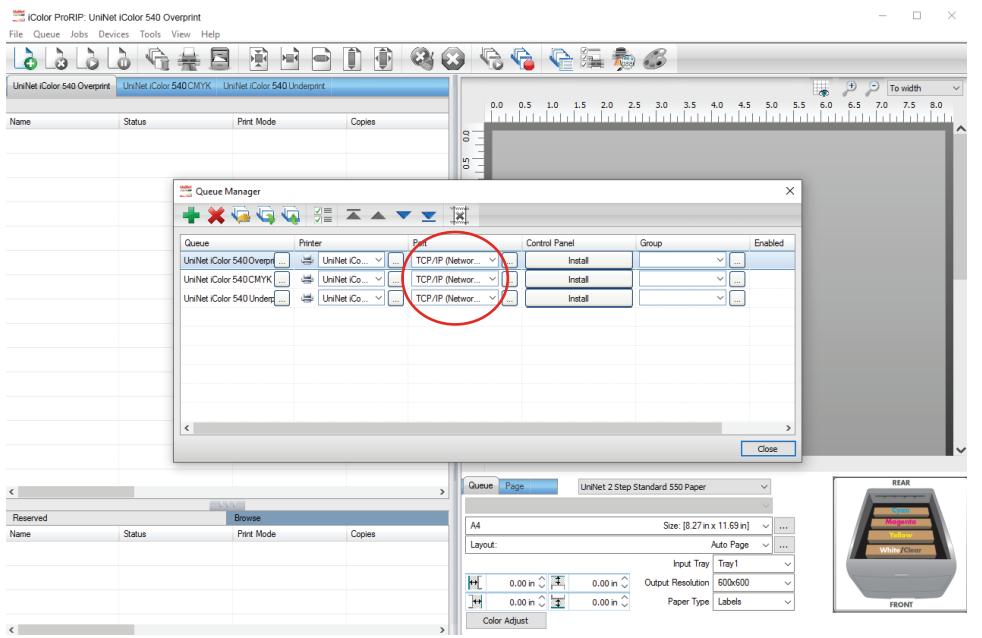
10. Setup is now complete.



11. Open the iColor ProRIP and click Queue/Manage Queues.

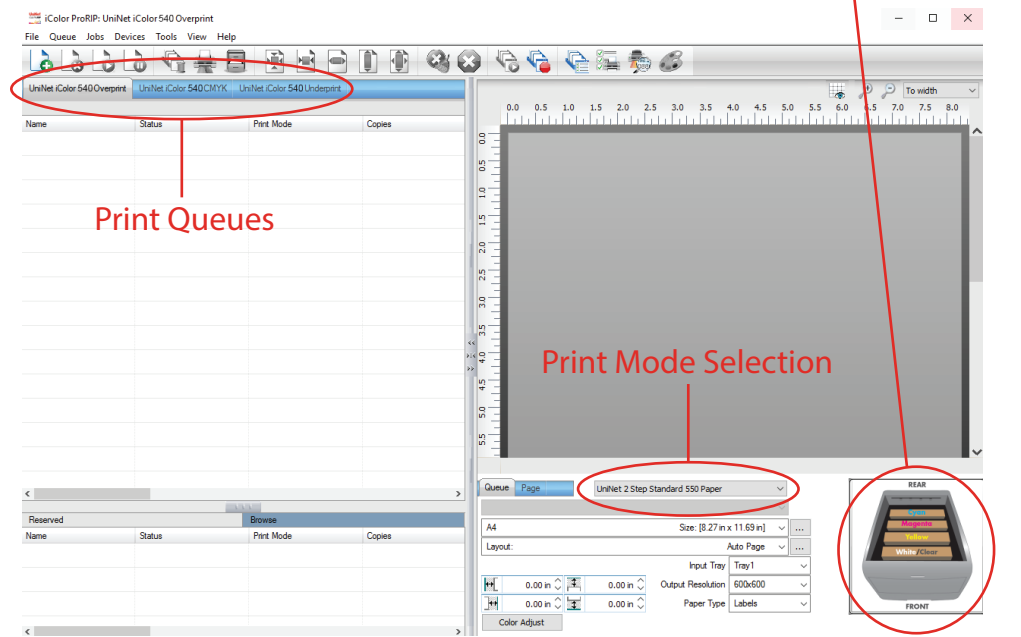


12. In the 'Port' drop down menu, choose the port, and click 'Close'.

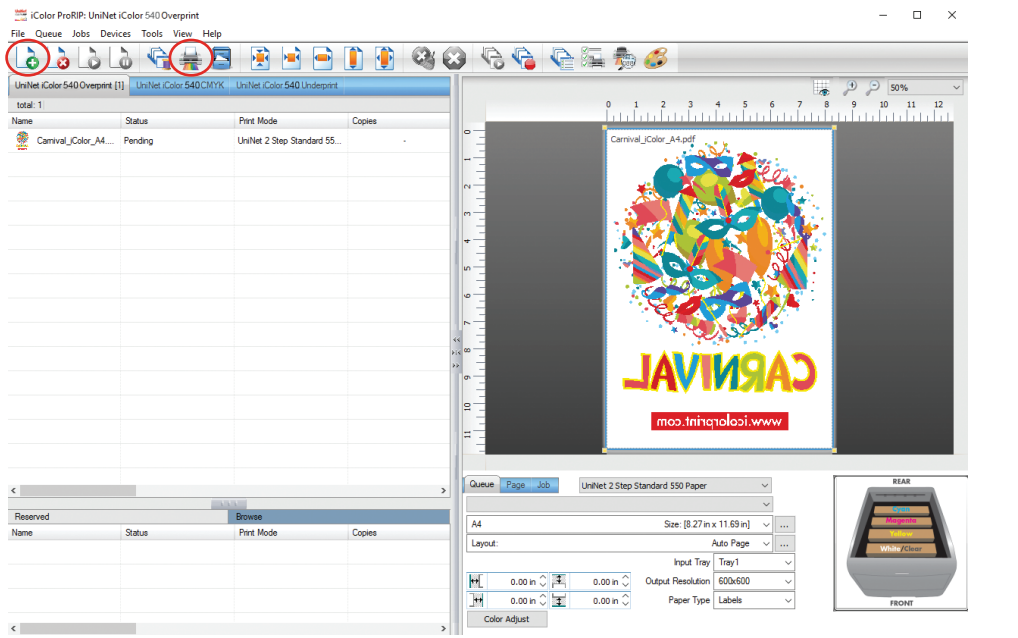
